



## COVID-19 Payer Updates

### COVID-19 CMS Update

As of 12:30pm ET on March 17, 2020 CMS has sent out an official notification stating that effective for services starting March 6, 2020 (retroactive), the limitations on where Medicare patients are eligible for telehealth services has been removed during the emergency. The waiver temporarily eliminates the requirement that the originating site must be a physician's office or other authorized healthcare facility and allows Medicare to pay for telehealth services when beneficiaries are in their homes or any setting of care.

CMS will temporarily pay clinicians for certain telehealth services. Each type of service is defined by conditions and reimbursement levels are outlined in the chart below.

#### *Medicaid Update for Infusion Centers*

South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHSS) will waive the requirement for direct supervision by a physician, nurse practitioner, or physician assistance for care provided at infusion centers. This is effective for dates of service on or after March 15, 2020.

### COVID-19 Commercial Payer Updates

As of March 19, 2020, the President signed the [Families First Coronavirus Response Act](#). This Act requires health insurance issuers to provide coverage for services related to the evaluation and management of COVID-19, and additionally applies to related services which may include in-person or telehealth provider visits, among others with no cost sharing, prior authorization or medical management requirements.
